Eligibility:

- Filipino or Filipino American
- Live in the Chicago land area
- Age 60 years old or higher



What's Involved:

- 30-minute one-on-one interview with someone from the FACHIC research team at the Rizal Center
- The interview contains questions on your background, your health history, your perceptions on the health status of your community and your opinions on the types of health programs available.
- Interviews will be audio-taped.
- Each participant will receive brochures and other health resources upon completion of the interview.
